

TIPS TO PREVENT THE INCIDENCE OF FURNITURE TIP OVER:

- Install tip-over restraint provided.
- Place heaviest items in the lower drawers.
- Unless specifically designed to accommodate, do not set TVs or other heavy objects on top of this product.
- Never allow children to climb or hang on drawers, doors or shelves.
- Never open more than one drawer at a time (OR)
- Do not defeat or remove the drawer interlock system.
- Use of tip-over restraints may only reduce, but not eliminate the risk of tip-over.

Note: Children like climbing on things, especially if there is something up high they want. Household furniture like bookshelves and entertainment units can be attractive to climb. So too, furniture like tallboys where pulled-out drawers act as stairs for climbing.



The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission recently undertook research into consumer awareness of furniture hazards in 2015 as a result of the increased incidents of child fatalities caused by toppling furniture.

If tipped over, the weight of the unit and its contents become a lethal force.

However, these injuries and fatalities can be prevented with just a little effort.

For furniture that is prone to toppling, it is important that it is secured to a wall. Anchor kits are provided with all our tallboy furniture, including easy step guide on how to use the systems provided.

It is essential you install anchor device provided with your item, carefully following assembly instructions to avoid serious toppling injury.

IMPORTANT: To prevent your furniture from tilting forward it is recommended that you:

- 1. Avoid fully opening all drawers at the same time
- 2. Avoid small children from climbing onto drawers
- 3. Securely attach the anti tilt straps provided to your wall

CAUTION: For your safety when attaching the anti tilt straps:

1. Check for any electrical wires or plumbing inside the wall before drilling any holes (if you are unsure please seek professional advice)

2. Walls are constructed from different materials eg; masonry (solid brick) or plaster board lined cavity walls (hollow). It is important that you use the appropriate wall fixings for your wall type. (your local hardware store will have the necessary drills and fixings and can offer advise if needed)
